

Dear Parents & Guardians,

Children's Safari Learning Center closely follows the COVID-19 situation. We understand this is a trying time and want to be here to support those in need of care and respect those who can keep children at home.

Currently Children's Safari Learning center continues to be open regular hours. We understand that you are concerned about being in the proximity of others. Children's Safari Learning Center assures our strict cleaning regimen will continue and we will be taking additional precautions recommended by our licensing agencies.

In addition to cleaning, other pre-cautions are:

\* There will be no fingerprint reader used for anyone. Teachers and children will be checked in and out by someone in admin. A staff member will always be at the front desk.

\* Only ONE individual will be able to go down the hall to drop off or pick up a child. All other family members and siblings must wait up front or in the car.

\* All visitors, other than therapists will be cancelled until further notice.

- Everyone above the age of 6 must wear a mask while in the center. Please refer to the following site to be sure the mask is being worn correctly:

\* Everyone will be screened upon entrance to the center. We will be taking the temperature of each person upon arrival and require quarantine for 14 days if the person presents with a fever of 100.0 or above or signs or symptoms of COVID listed on the CDC website. If someone has traveled internationally, domestically, or has come in contact with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19, is under investigation for COVID-19, or is ill with a respiratory illness we will require no entry to the center for a minimum 14 days.
